

Scholarship Application Information

Assyrians Without Borders is a Swedish non-profit organisation devoted to improving the lives of the Assyrian people (also known as Syriacs and Chaldeans) in their countries of origin (Turkey, Iraq, Iran, Syria and Lebanon). Assyrians Without Borders conducts an independent activity and is politically and religiously unbound.

It is a well-known fact that education is one of the most essential factors that contribute to the well-being of an individual. This is more evident in the Middle East than in the Western world where conditions are different. As a result, Assyrians Without Borders regards the financial assistance of Assyrian students in their countries of origin as a constructive and necessary form of support, one that will help each of them secure a successful future.

The criteria to apply for Assyrians Without Borders scholarships are that the applicant:

- A) Is Assyrian (as defined above)
- B) Lives in Turkey, Iraq, Iran, Syria or Lebanon
- C) Is admitted to university studies

Awards are made at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee based on the availability of funds and the final decision is taken by the board of Assyrians Without Borders. If granted a scholarship, you will receive all funds after the decisions are finalised.

Please read the instructions carefully and submit a complete application. Scholarship awards will be based on your application, personal essay, goals, honours/activities, letter of recommendation and financial need.

Application Checklist:

All of the below documents must be sent in ONE email to scholarship@awbswe.com. Write "Assyrians Without Borders Scholarship Application" followed by your first name and family name in the Subject line of your email.

- A) Completed Scholarship Application
- B) Letter of recommendation from a faculty supervisor
- C) Digital scan of the proof of admission from your university
- D) Digital scan of your student card
- E) Digital scan of your passport or ID card
- F) Digital scan of your official transcript of courses and marks
- G) Digital scan of your bank account information with correct account holder name and account number
- H) A waist-up photo of yourself





You will receive a confirmation email when Assyrians Without Borders has received your submission. Only complete applications will be considered. Under normal circumstances it takes approximately two months to process an application and recipients will be notified via email once a decision is made.

Note that if granted a scholarship, you will receive the funds when the decision is taken. In addition, at the end of the term, you will receive a form for financial reporting. In this form you will state how you used the granted scholarship funds and scan a copy of your final grades for that term.

Fill in all boxes on the upcoming pages with all required information. The Application, letter of recommendation and proof of admission must be written in English. All currency values must be in Euros.
